Dear Anthony,

Thank you for your email of 22 March.

We have discussed this with the Committee and we accept your offer of a £150 reduction for 2012/13, this being for the reduction in facilities and services since October 2009. We hope the facilities and services will be restored during 2012/13.

In accordance with the agreed mechanism for setting fees, the £150 will be deducted from the agreed core fee of £2,691.82 to give £2,541.82, to ensure compliance with VAT accounting. Adding VAT at 20% will show the revised fee for 2012/13 is £3,050.18. As agreed on 23 March, a jointly-agreed letter from Darwin and the Association will be sent to owners regarding the reduction of £150 and the revised fee. No doubt you will make similar arrangements for those with a Darwin licence issued since October 2009.

At the meeting with James, Andy, NACO and the Association on 23 March it was agreed that NACO would draft a licence based on OFT 734, the issues we raised in our letter of 12 March, and those raised by NACO themselves. We also noted James' points. It seems appropriate that NACO draft the licence for Darwin to agree and the Association to agree on behalf of its members, as it is authorised to do. The aim is to have a licence agreed by 1 June 2012.

We look forward to being advised of the revised fee as soon as possible, showing the reduction of £150 from the core fee.

Those at the packed General Meeting on 24 March were delighted at the £150 reduction as above, a jointly-agreed letter and that NACO were drafting a revised licence.
